Banana Nut Bread by Cindy Beck

Ingredients: 1 C sugar; 1 C butter; 2 eggs beaten; 1 ½ C mashed bananas; 2 ¼ C flour; 1 tsp. baking soda; ½ tsp. salt; ¼ C buttermilk; ½ C chopped pecans or walnuts; 2 tsp. vanilla.

Cream butter and sugar together, add eggs, vanilla, and bananas. Mix well and add remaining ingredients. Bake in small bread pans at 350 degrees for about 30 to 35 minutes.

If baked in larger bread pans allow bread to bake longer.
