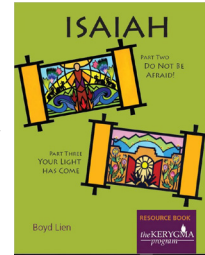

Wednesday Morning Bible Study Part Three of Isaiah – Your Light Has Come Chapters 56-66

Meet in the Narthex / 9:30 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.

This study will look at God's people returning from exile in Babylon and those who stayed behind. In Jerusalem struggle to overcome differences and reestablish a community. How will God's people come together to share in God's future? Isaiah speaks of God's house as a house of prayer for all peoples, describes God as reaching out to all nations, and communicates God's promises in ways that capture the attention and imagination of a struggling community—and eventually the attention of a New Testament community, as Jesus reads from Isaiah 61 to identify himself and his mission.
